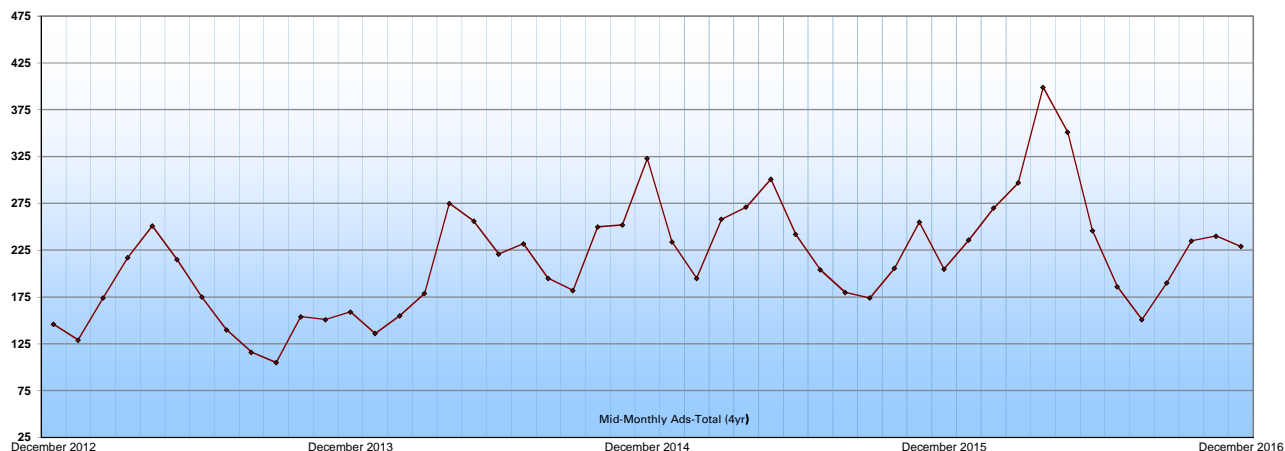


December 2016 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 229 internship ads were posted online from November 14, 2016, through December 13, 2016, for west Ohio. This was a decrease of 11 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 24 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
