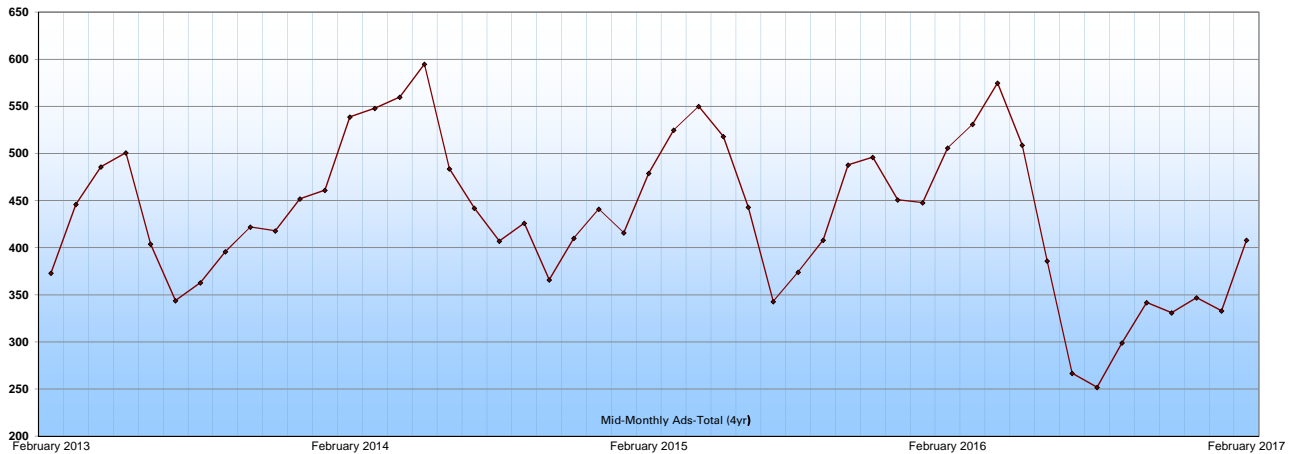


**February 2017 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads**

A total of 408 internship ads were posted online from January 14, 2017, through February 13, 2017, for central Ohio. This was an increase of 75 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 98 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
