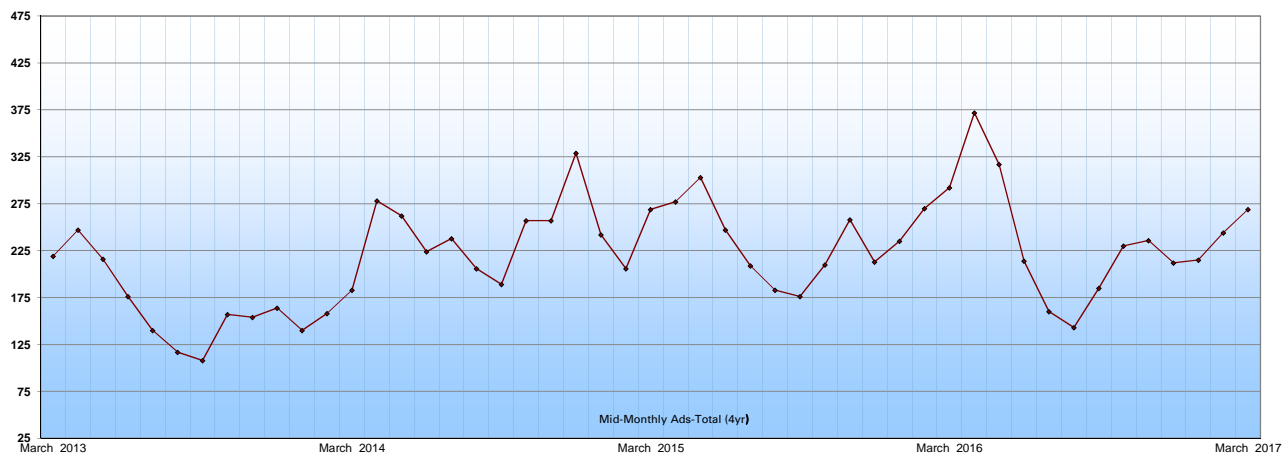


March 2017 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 269 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2017, through March 13, 2017, for west Ohio. This was an increase of 25 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 23 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
