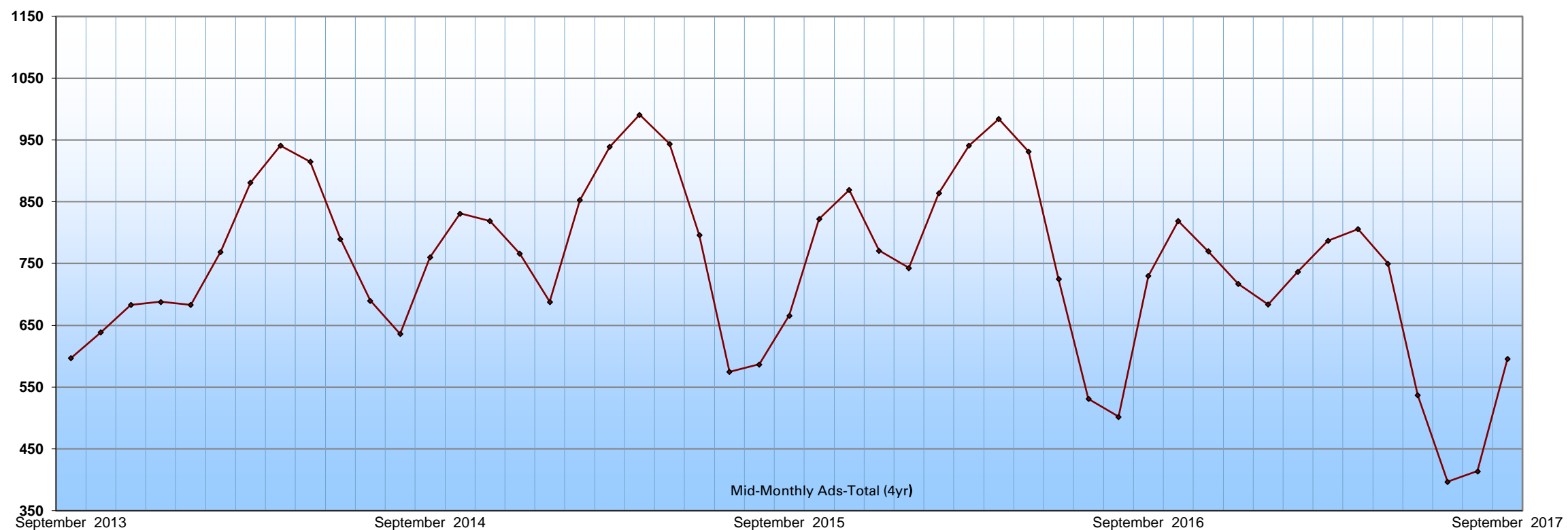


### September 2017 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 596 internship ads were posted online from August 14, 2017, through September 13, 2017, for northeast Ohio. This was an increase of 182 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 134 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
