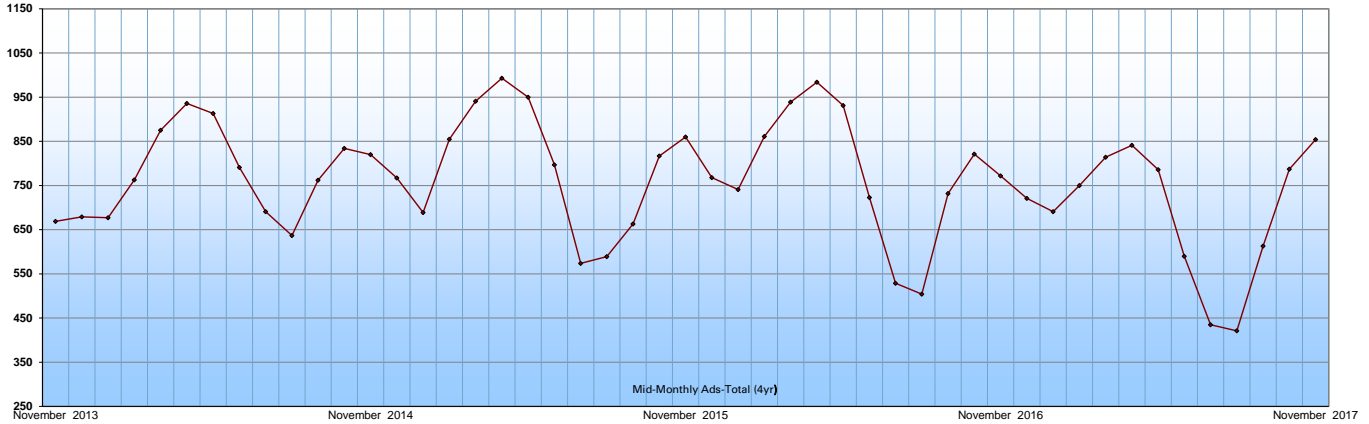


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

### November 2017 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 854 internship ads were posted online from October 14, 2017, through November 13, 2017, for northeast Ohio. This was an increase of 67 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 82 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
