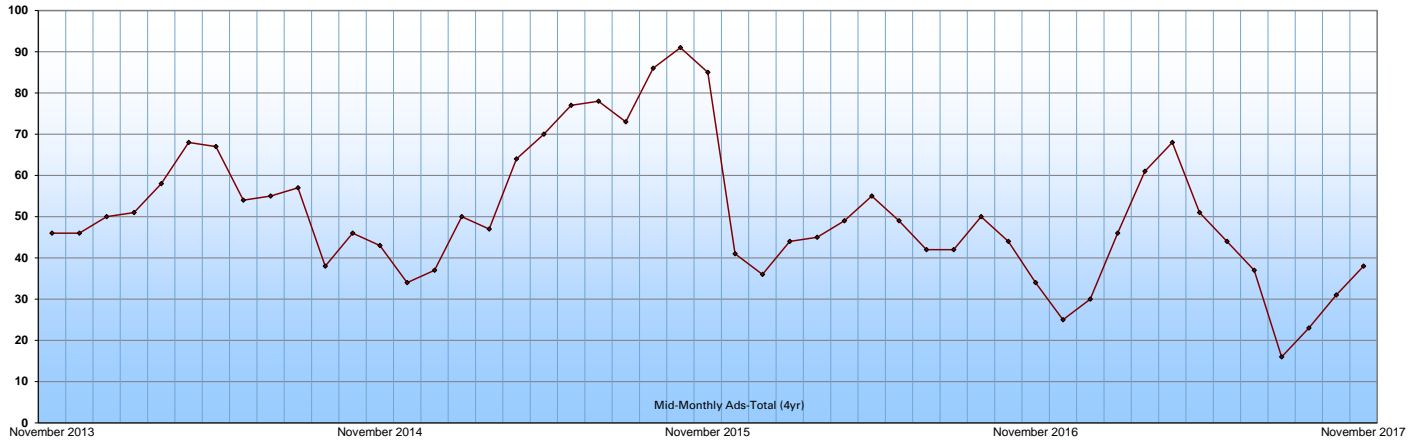


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southeast JobsOhio Network

### November 2017 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 38 internship ads were posted online from October 14, 2017, through November 13, 2017, for southeast Ohio. This was an increase of seven ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of four ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
