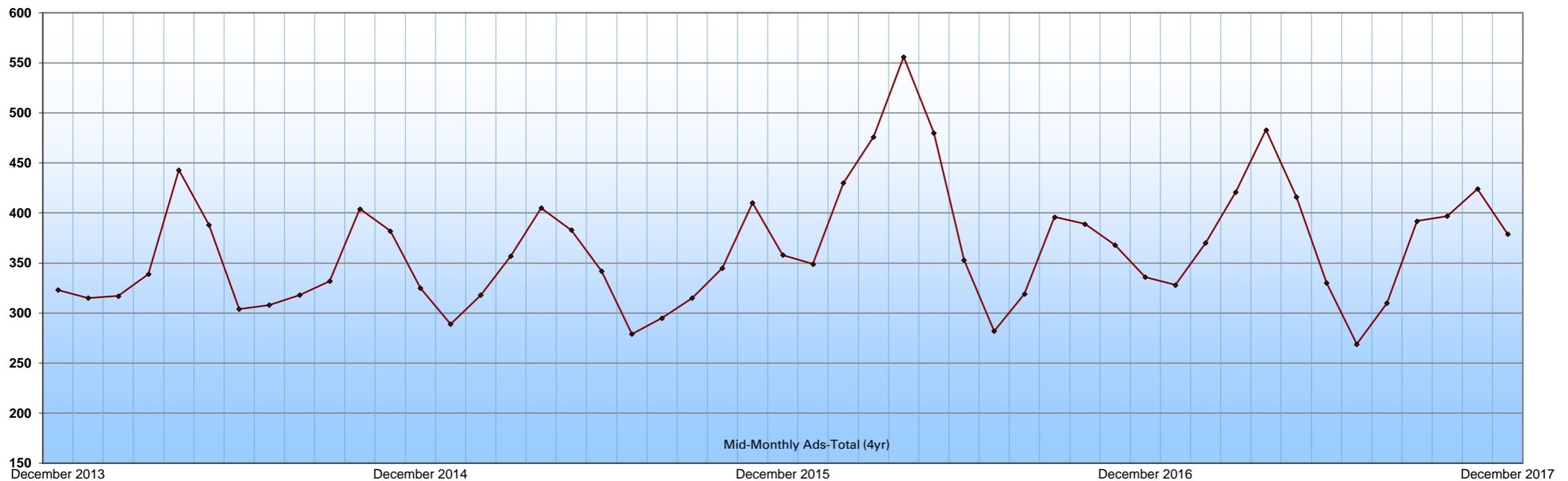


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

December 2017 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 379 internship ads were posted online from November 14, 2017, through December 13, 2017, for southwest Ohio. This was a decrease of 45 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 43 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
