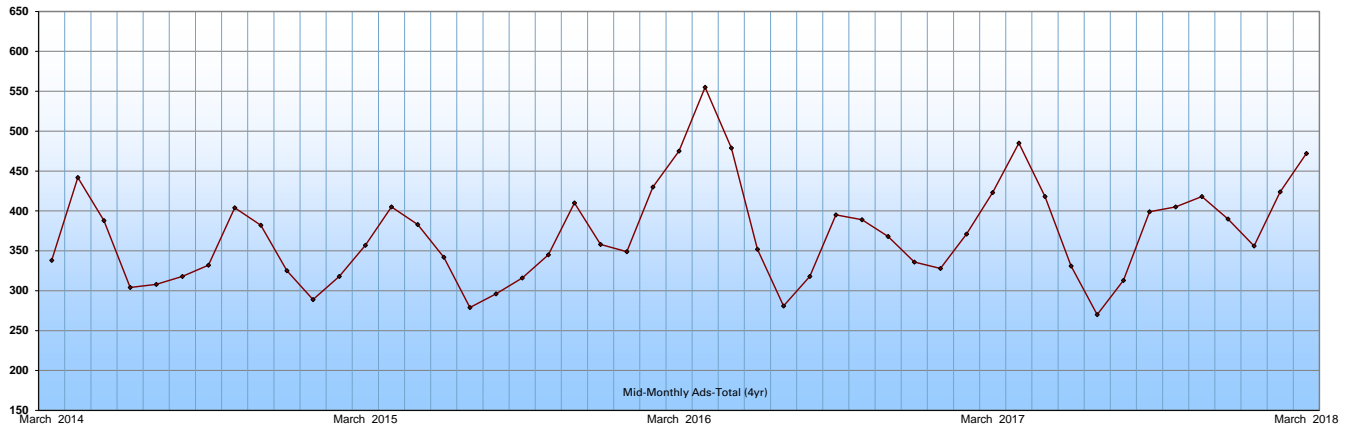


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

March 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 472 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2018, through March 13, 2018, for southwest Ohio. This was an increase of 48 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 49 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
