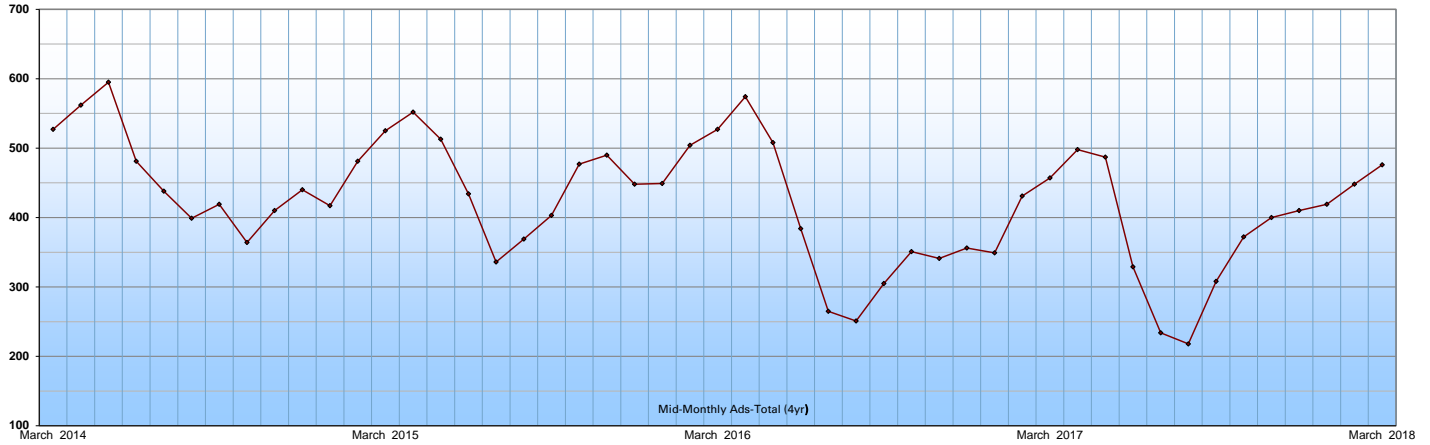


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Central JobsOhio Network

March 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 476 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2018, through March 13, 2018, for central Ohio. This was an increase of 28 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 19 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
