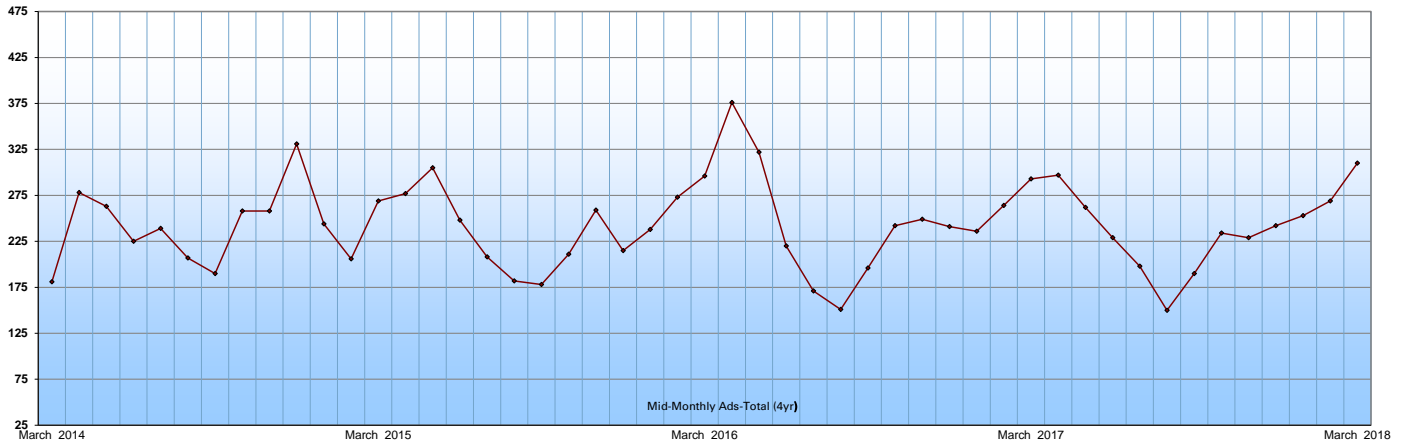


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the West JobsOhio Network

March 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 310 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2018, through March 13, 2018, for west Ohio. This was an increase of 41 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 17 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
