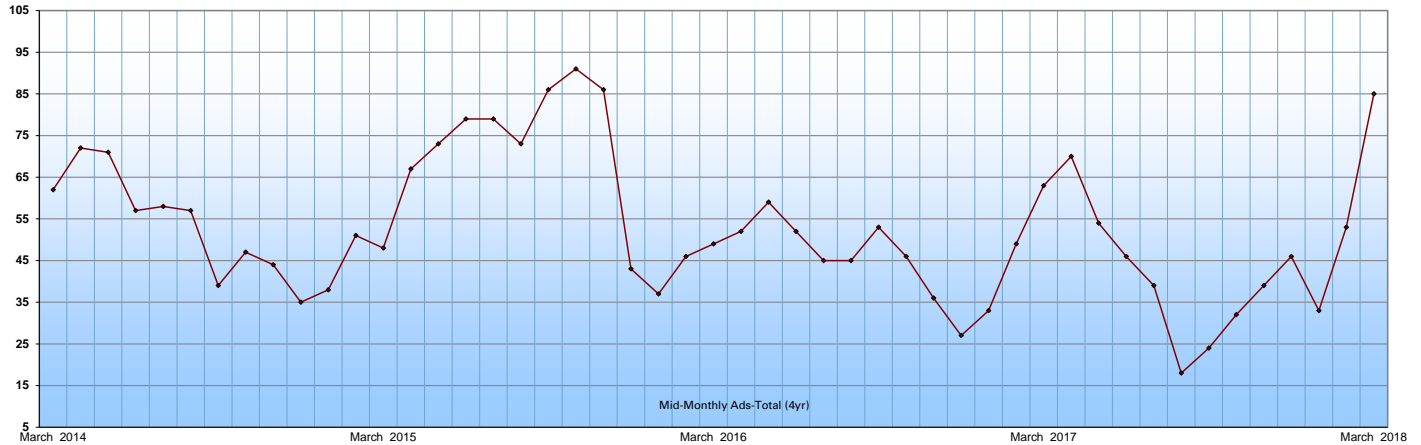


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southeast JobsOhio Network

March 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 85 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2018, through March 13, 2018, for southeast Ohio. This was an increase of 32 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 22 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
