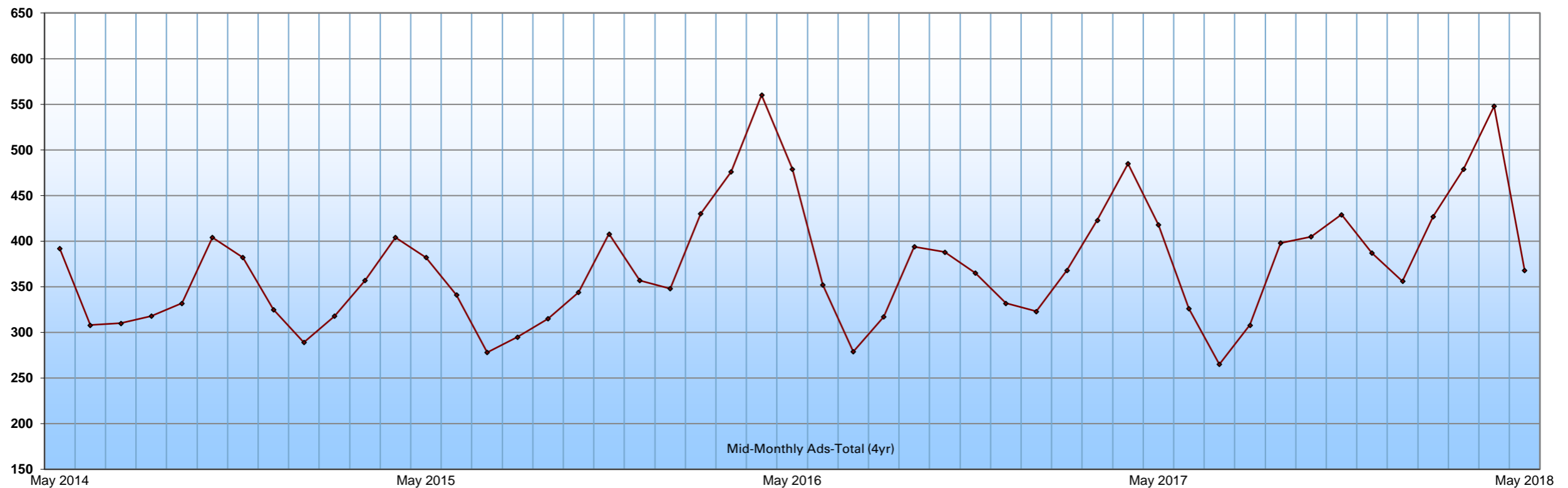


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

### May 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 368 internship ads were posted online from April 14, 2018, through May 13, 2018, for southwest Ohio. This was an decrease of 180 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 50 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
