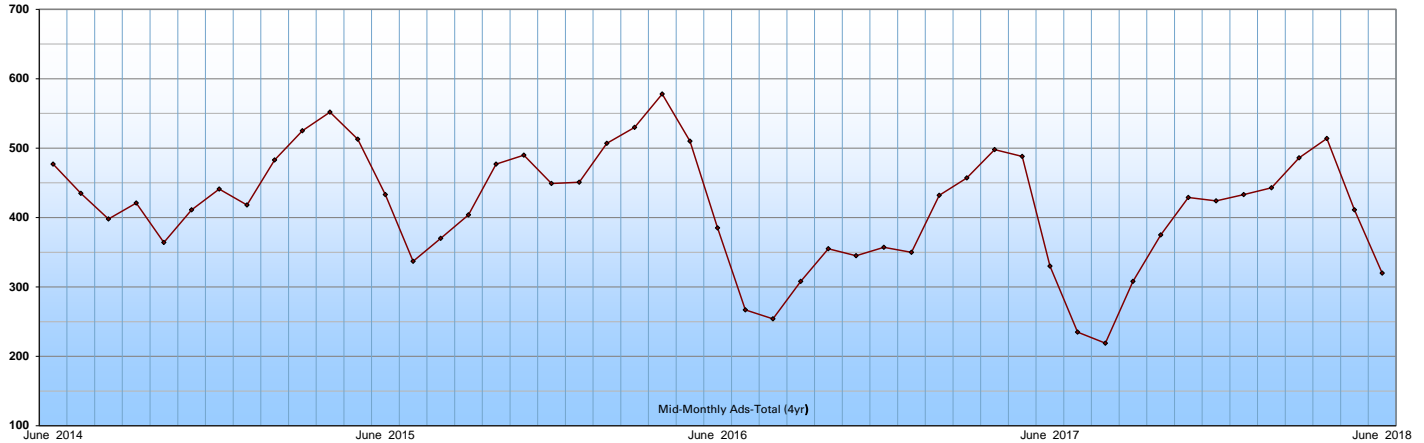


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Central JobsOhio Network

June 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 320 internship ads were posted online from May 14, 2018, through June 13, 2018, for central Ohio. This was a decrease of 91 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 10 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
