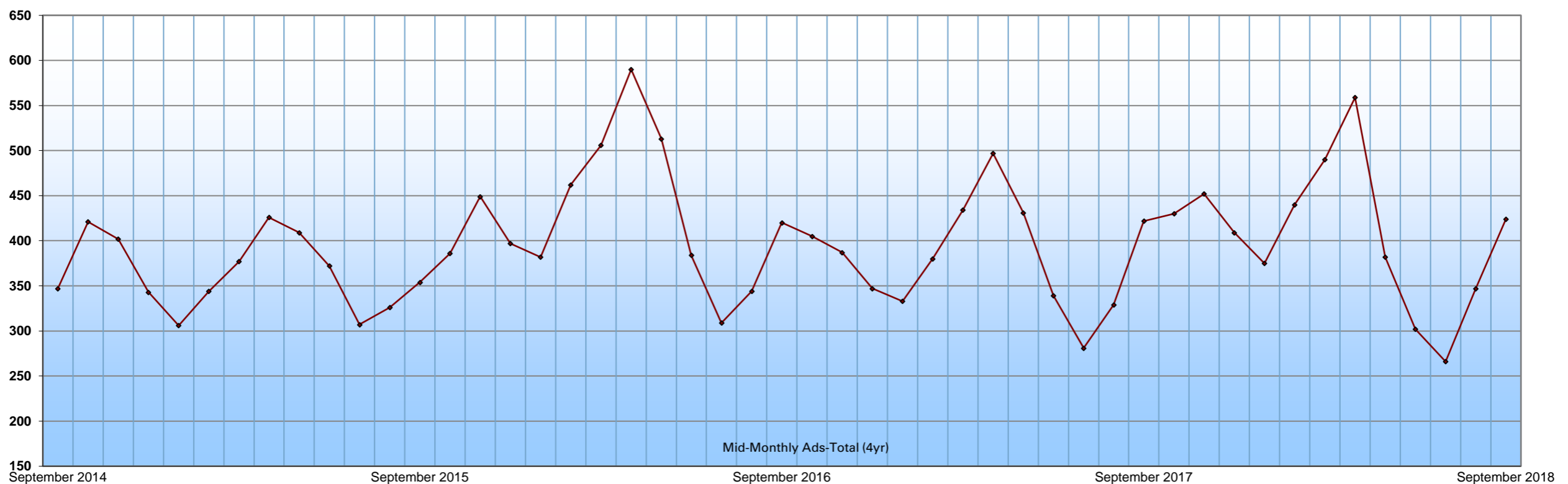


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

### September 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 424 internship ads were posted online from August 14, 2018, through September 13, 2018, for southwest Ohio. This was an increase of 77 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of two ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
