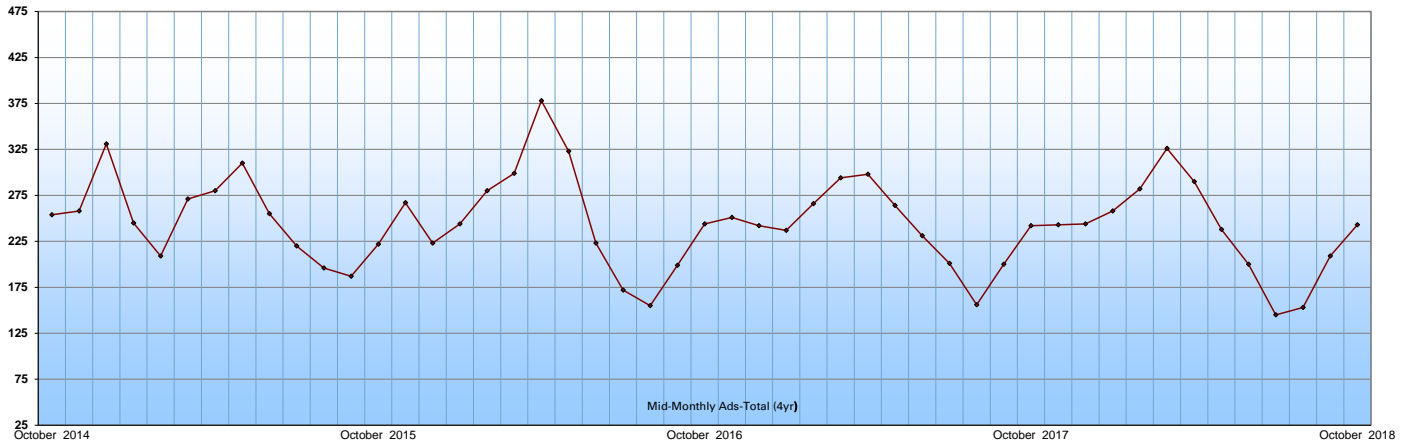


# Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the West JobsOhio Network

## October 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 243 internship ads were posted online from September 14, 2018, through October 13, 2018, for west Ohio. This was an increase of 34 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of one ad compared to the same time period a year ago.
