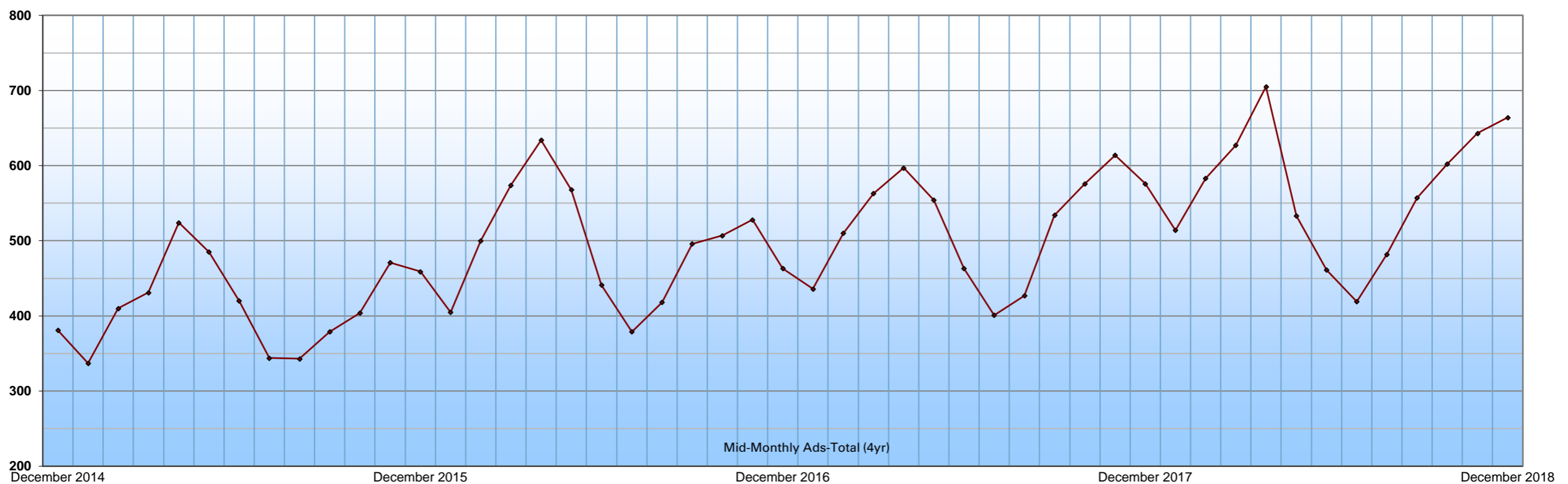


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

December 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 664 internship ads were posted online from November 14, 2018, through December 13, 2018, for southwest Ohio. This was an increase of 21 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 88 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
