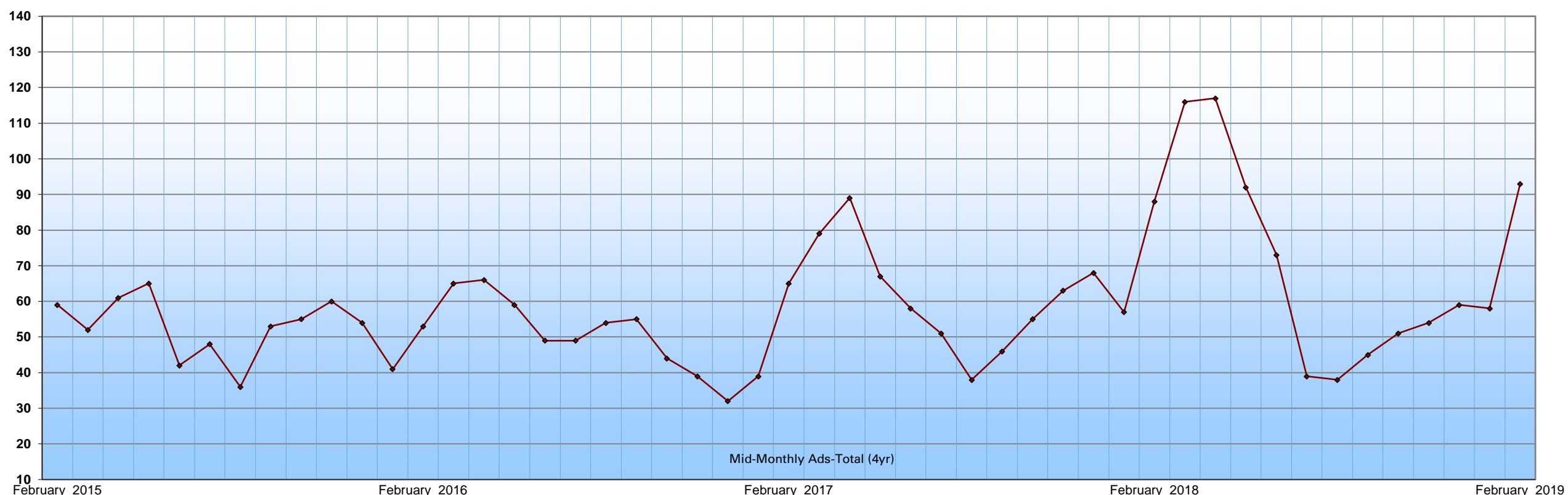

February 2019 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 93 internship ads were posted online from January 14, 2019, through February 13, 2019, for southeast Ohio. This was an increase of 35 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of five ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
