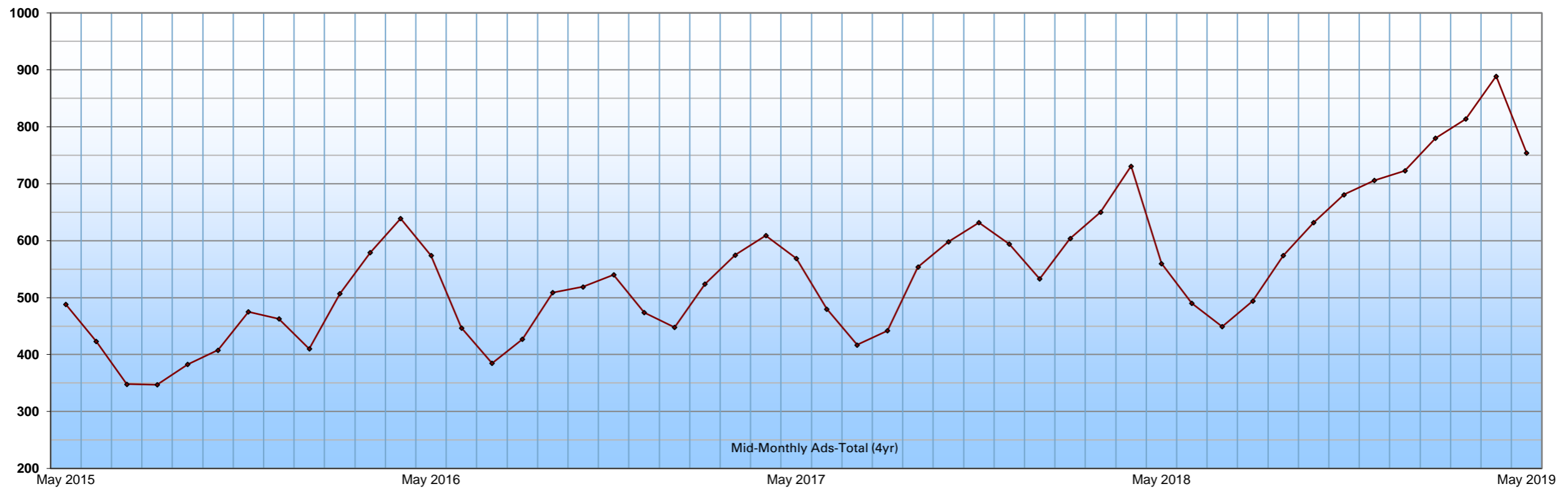


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

May 2019 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 754 internship ads were posted online from April 14, 2019, through May 13, 2019, for southwest Ohio. This was a decrease of 135 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 194 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
