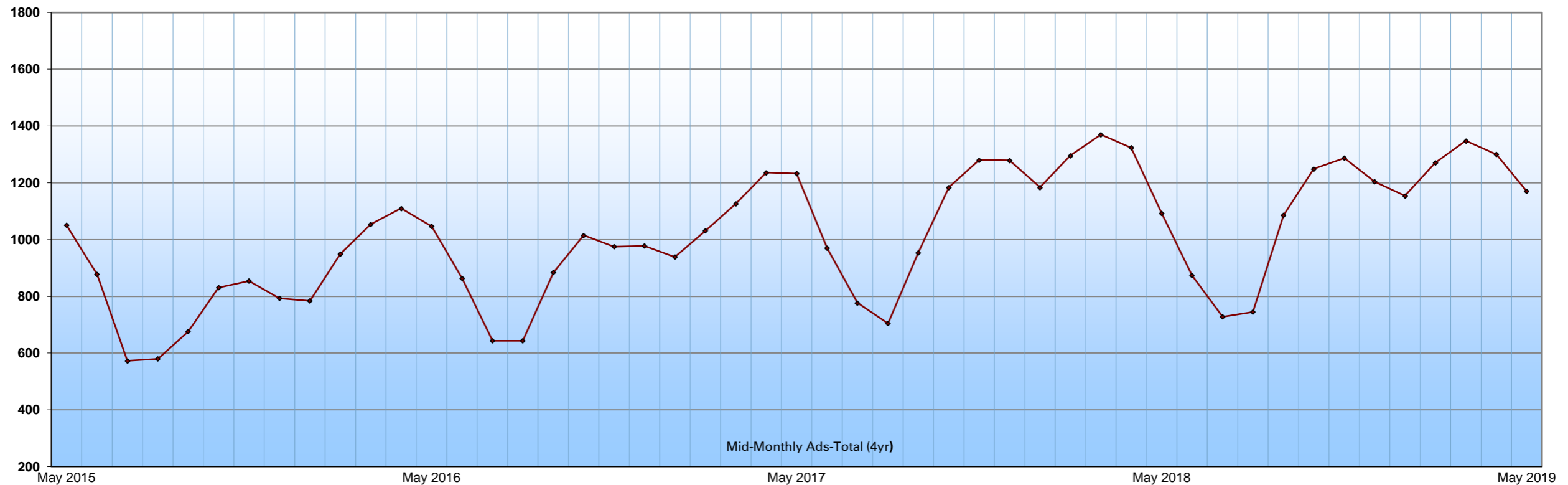


## Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

### May 2019 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 1,170 internship ads were posted online from April 14, 2019, through May 13, 2019, for northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 53 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 38 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
