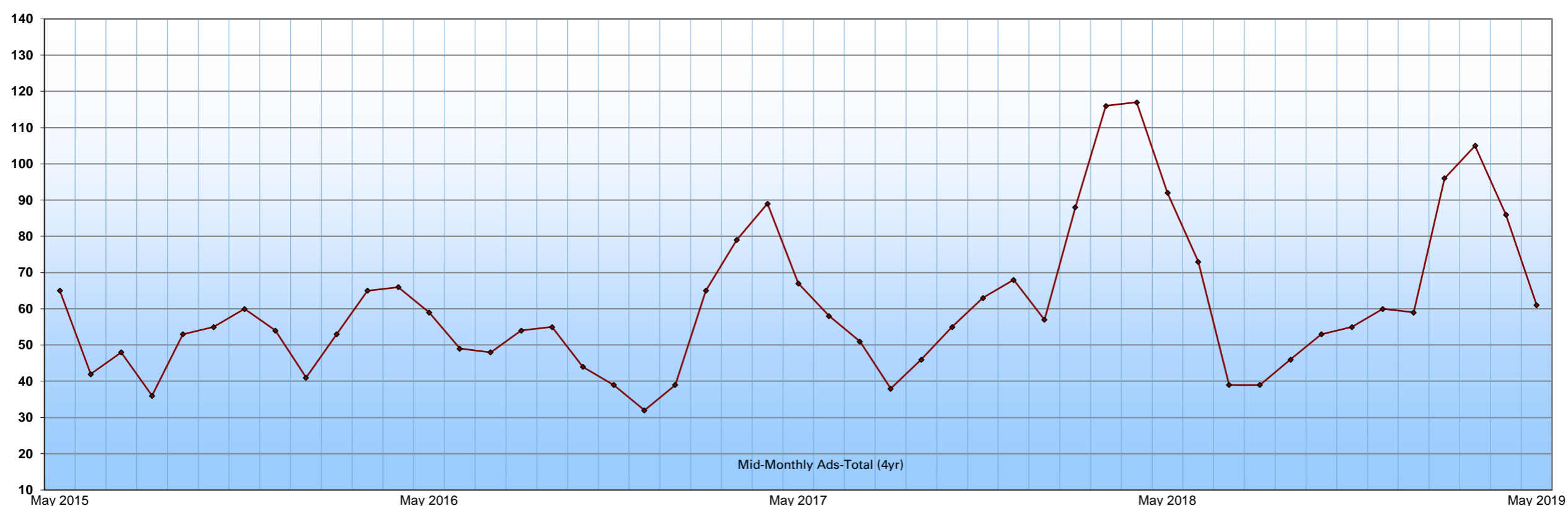


### May 2019 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 61 internship ads were posted online from April 14, 2019, through May 13, 2019, for southeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 25 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 31 ads compared to the same time period a year ago.
