

## **Online Internship Postings** in the Eastern JobsOhio Network

December 2024

A total of 96 internship ads were posted online from November 14, 2024, through December 13, 2024, for eastern Ohio. There was a decrease of 19 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 27 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.

Seasonal variation in employment occurs for natural and institutional reasons, including reduced employment involving outdoor activities during winter, changes in labor force and unemployment levels with opening and closing of schools, and layoffs during the automobile model changeover period. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
