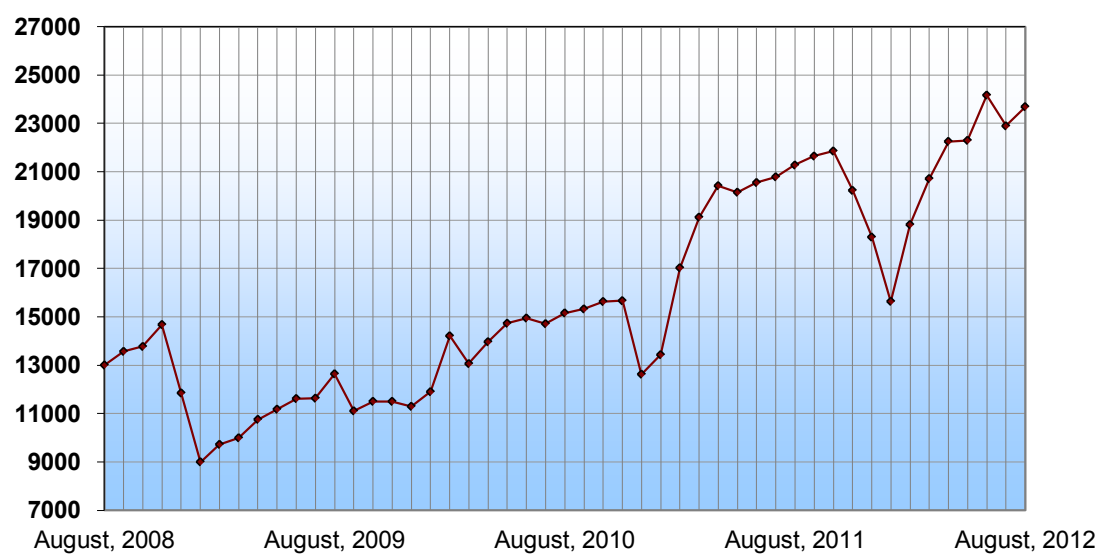


OhioMeansJobs.com August Snapshot of Dayton Area OnLine® Job Postings

More than 23,600 job openings were posted online from July 14, 2012, through August 13, 2012, for Auglaize, Champaign, Clark, Clinton, Darke, Fayette, Greene, Mercer, Miami, Montgomery, Preble and Shelby counties, according to data from The Conference Board, a global, not-for-profit independent business and research association. This was an increase of 794 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflected an increase of 2,414 ads. This information is a snapshot in time and may not represent long-term trends. This data has not been seasonally adjusted. Seasonal adjustment is used to remove fluctuations in unemployment and labor force trends that normally occur with changes in the season. Seasonal variation in employment occurs for natural and institutional reasons, including less employment involving outdoor activities during winter, changes in labor force and unemployment levels with opening and closing of schools, and layoffs during the automobile model changeover period. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
