

# April Snapshot of Nelsonville-Southeast Ohio Area OnLine® Job Postings

More than 7,100 job openings were posted online from March 14, 2013, through April 13, 2013, for Adams, Athens, Belmont, Carroll, Coshocton, Gallia, Guernsey, Harrison, Highland, Hocking, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Lawrence, Meigs, Monroe, Morgan, Muskingum, Noble, Perry, Pike, Ross, Scioto, Vinton and Washington counties, according to data from The Conference Board, a global, not-for-profit independent business and research association. This was an increase of 692 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects an increase of 974 ads.
