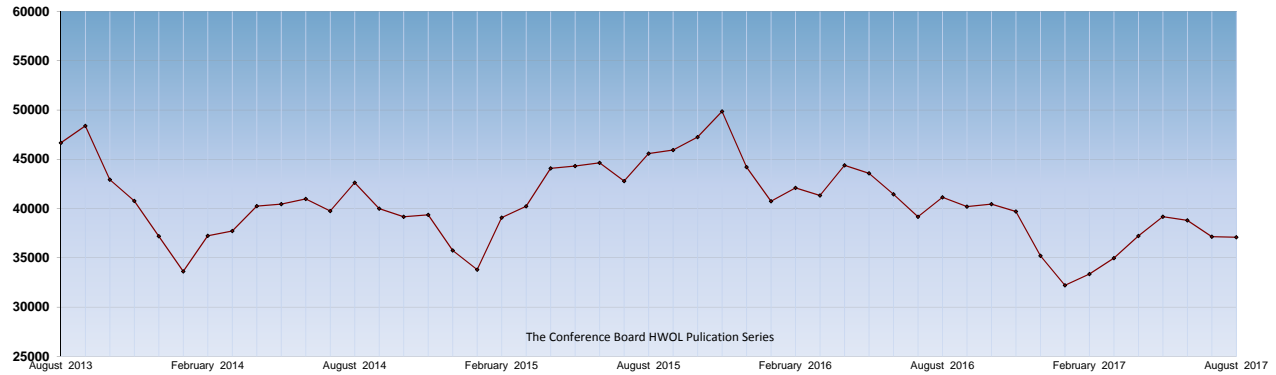


A total of 37,090 job openings were posted online from July 14, 2017, through August 13, 2017, for Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Knox, Licking, Logan, Madison, Marion, Morrow, Pickaway and Union counties, according to data from The Conference Board. This was a decrease of 53 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects a decrease of 4,050 ads. The graph below shows historical trends for ads posted in this area over the last several years.

Seasonal variation in employment occurs for natural and institutional reasons, including reduced employment involving outdoor activities during winter, changes in labor force and unemployment levels with opening and closing of schools, and layoffs during the automobile model changeover period. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
