

A total of 33,056 job openings were posted online from September 14, 2018, through October 13, 2018, for Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Knox, Licking, Logan, Madison, Marion, Morrow, Pickaway and Union counties, according to data from The Conference Board. This was a decrease of 1,634 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects a decrease of 4,053 ads. The graph below shows historical trends for ads posted in this area over the last several years.
