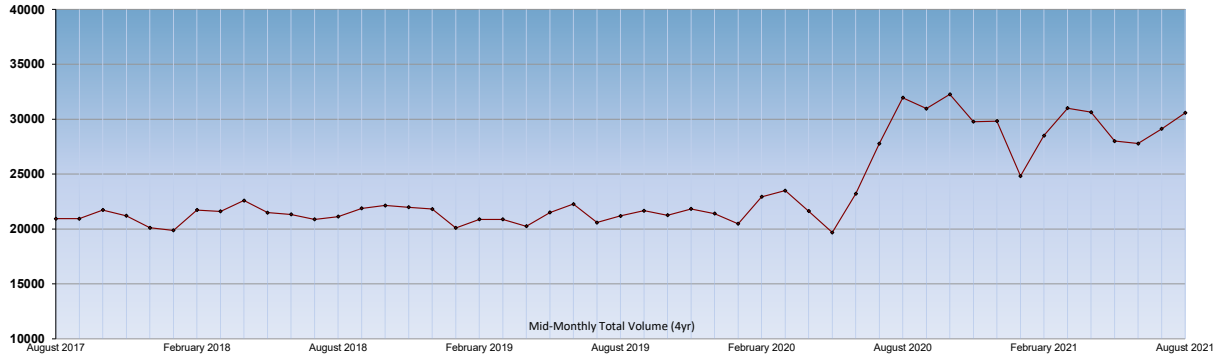


A total of 30,574 job openings were posted online from July 14, 2021, through August 13, 2021, for Auglaize, Champaign, Clark, Clinton, Darke, Fayette, Greene, Mercer, Miami, Montgomery, Preble and Shelby counties. This was an increase of 1,449 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects a decrease of 1,383 ads. The graph below shows historical trends for ads posted in this area over the last several years.

This information is a snapshot in time and may not represent long-term trends. This data has not been seasonally adjusted. Sometimes seasonal adjustment is used to remove fluctuations in unemployment and labor force trends that normally occur with changes in the season. Seasonal variation in employment occurs for natural and institutional reasons, including reduced employment involving outdoor activities during winter, changes in labor force and unemployment levels with opening and closing of schools, and layoffs during the automobile model changeover period. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
