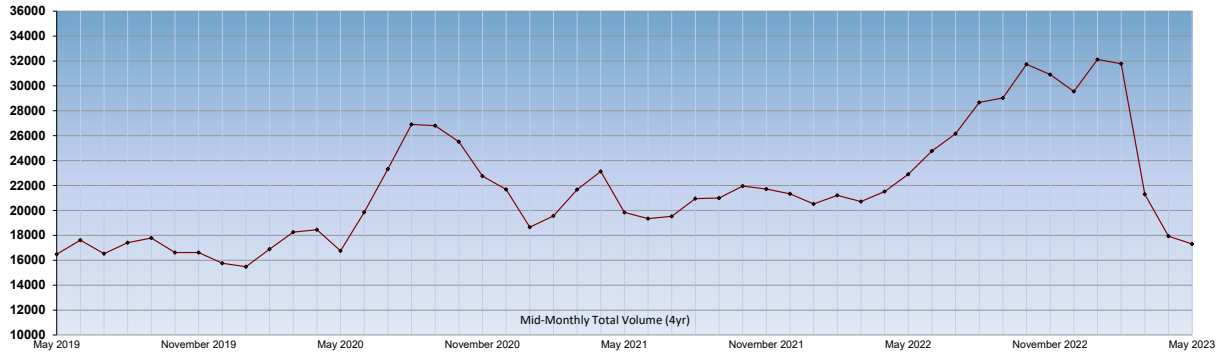


A total of 17,308 job openings were posted online from April 14, 2023, through May 13, 2023, for Allen, Crawford, Defiance, Fulton, Hancock, Hardin, Henry, Lucas, Ottawa, Paulding, Putnam, Sandusky, Seneca, Van Wert, Williams, Wood and Wyandot counties. This was a decrease of 617 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects a decrease of 5,593 ads. The graph below shows historical trends for ads posted in this area over the last several years.

This reflects a change from the methodology used to produce these reports prior to August 2022.

This information is a snapshot in time and may not represent long-term trends. This data has not been seasonally adjusted. Sometimes seasonal adjustment is used to remove fluctuations in unemployment and labor force trends that normally occur with changes in the season. Seasonal variation in employment occurs for natural and institutional reasons, including reduced employment involving outdoor activities during winter, changes in labor force and unemployment levels with opening and closing of schools, and layoffs during the automobile model changeover period. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
