Aerospace and Aviation Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2019, the aerospace and aviation industry cluster's average annual pay was **\$100,341¹**. During this same time period, Ohio's statewide private industry average annual wage was \$51,726.
- The aerospace and aviation industry is expected to provide **3,776** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
