Automotive Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2019, the automotive industry cluster’s average annual pay was **\$63,649¹**. During this same time period, Ohio’s statewide private industry average annual wage was \$51,726.
- The automotive industry is expected to provide **12,450** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
