# Energy and Chemicals Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2019, the energy and chemicals industry cluster’s average annual pay was **\$90,035<sup>1</sup>**. During this same time period, Ohio’s statewide private industry average annual wage was \$51,726.
- The energy and chemicals industry is expected to provide **9,327** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
