Financial Services Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2019, the financial services industry cluster’s average annual pay was **\$86,646¹**. During this same time period, Ohio’s statewide private industry average annual wage was \$51,726.
- The financial services industry is expected to provide **19,878** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
