# Food and Agribusiness Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2019, the food and agribusiness industry cluster's average annual pay was **\$52,618<sup>1</sup>**. During this same time period, Ohio's statewide private industry average annual wage was \$51,726.
- The food and agribusiness industry is expected to provide **8,958** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
