SNAPSHOT

- In 2019, the technology industry cluster’s average annual pay was **\$90,822¹**. During this same time period, Ohio’s statewide private industry average annual wage was \$51,726.
- The technology industry is expected to provide **9,235** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
