Did You Know?

In 2023, Ohio's labor force included 738,000 African Americans, 698,000 of whom were employed. Compared to its total working age population, this demographic's labor force participation rate of 63.7% exceeded the state average of 61.9%, and its employment-to-population ratio of 60.3% also exceeded the state average of 59.8%.
