

Weekly Analysis

May 28, 2022

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 8,817 last week, an increase of 6.3 percent from the prior week's figure of 8,293 and a 47.7 percent decrease from the May 2021 weekly average of 16,866. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 13. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled 6.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 28,587 last week, a decrease of 5.2 percent from the prior week's figure of 30,166 and a 74.5 percent decrease from the May 2021 weekly average of 112,080. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 142. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 116 while PUA continued claims totaled 1,130. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
