

Weekly Analysis

August 20, 2022

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 6,310 last week, an increase of 1.3 percent from the prior week's figure of 6,227 and a 44.4 percent decrease from the August 2021 weekly average of 11,341. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 16. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 31,358 last week, a decrease of 4.4 percent from the prior week's figure of 32,786 and a 50.2 percent decrease from the August 2021 weekly average of 62,936. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 141. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 136 while PUA continued claims totaled 339. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
