

Weekly Analysis

June 3, 2023

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 16,800 last week, an increase of 62.2 percent from the prior week's figure of 10,355 and a 47.5 percent increase from the June 2022 weekly average of 11,393. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 13. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled 1.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 39,292 last week, an increase of 0.5 percent from the prior week's figure of 39,105 and a 26.9 percent increase from the June 2022 weekly average of 30,963. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 139. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 41 while PUA continued claims totaled 109. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
