

Weekly Analysis

November 2, 2024

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 8,051 last week, an increase of 32.8 percent from the prior week's figure of 6,062 and a 5.0 percent increase from the November 2023 weekly average of 7,666. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 17. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 43,422 last week, an increase of 3.3 percent from the prior week's figure of 42,037 and a 16.9 percent increase from the November 2023 weekly average of 37,140. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 123. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 9 while PUA continued claims totaled zero. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
