

Weekly Analysis

March 15, 2025

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 5,462 last week, a decrease of 7.0 percent from the prior week's figure of 5,875 and a 7.2 percent increase from the March 2024 weekly average of 5,095. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 21. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 64,334 last week, a decrease of 3.3 percent from the prior week's figure of 66,515 and a 14.6 percent increase from the March 2024 weekly average of 56,161. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 217. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 1 while PUA continued claims totaled 1. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
