


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

January 2019 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 798 internship ads were posted online from December 14, 2018, through January 13, 2019, for southwest Ohio. This was an increase of 13 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 281 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
