

Snapshot of Ohio Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads



Summary

For the last 30-day reporting period (May 14 - June 13), **1,032** Help Wanted OnLine® (HWOL) ads were posted for internships, according to data from The Conference Board. This is a decrease of 435 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects a decrease of 357 ads. In addition, the graph below reflects monthly trends of new internship ads posted through June 13, 2012.
