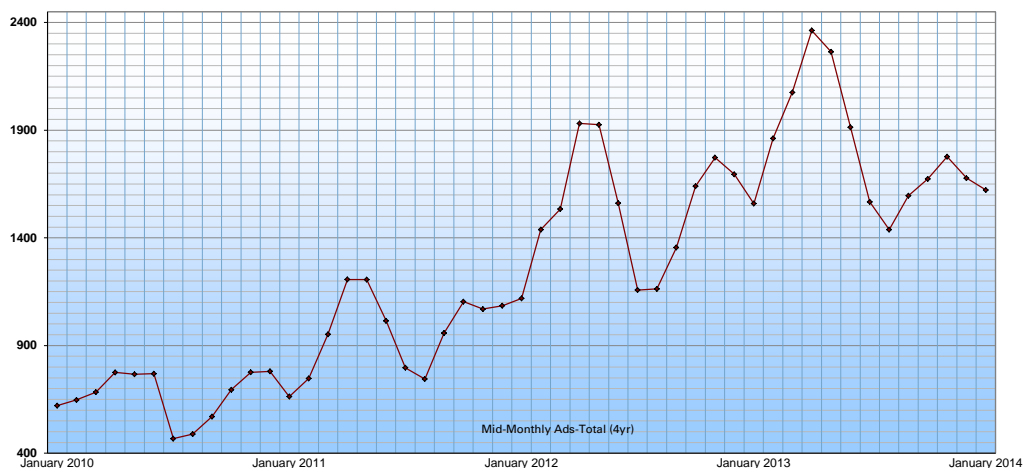


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads State of Ohio

January 2014 Snapshot of 1,622 Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

More than 1,600 internship openings were posted online from December 14, 2013, through January 13, 2014, for Ohio. This was a decrease of 55 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 63 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows new internship ads posted each month in this area from January 2010 through January 2014.
