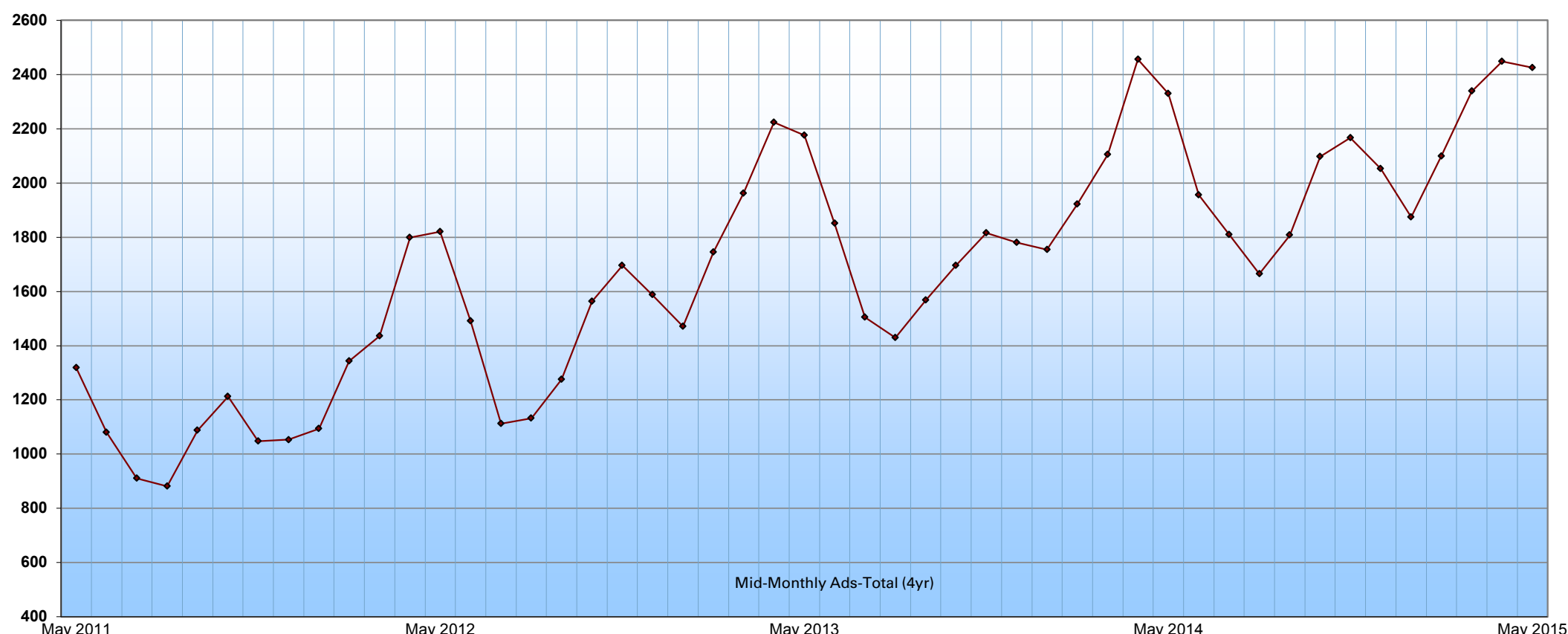

May 2015 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 2,425 internship ads were posted online from April 14, 2015, through May 13, 2015, for Ohio. This was a decrease of 23 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 96 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
