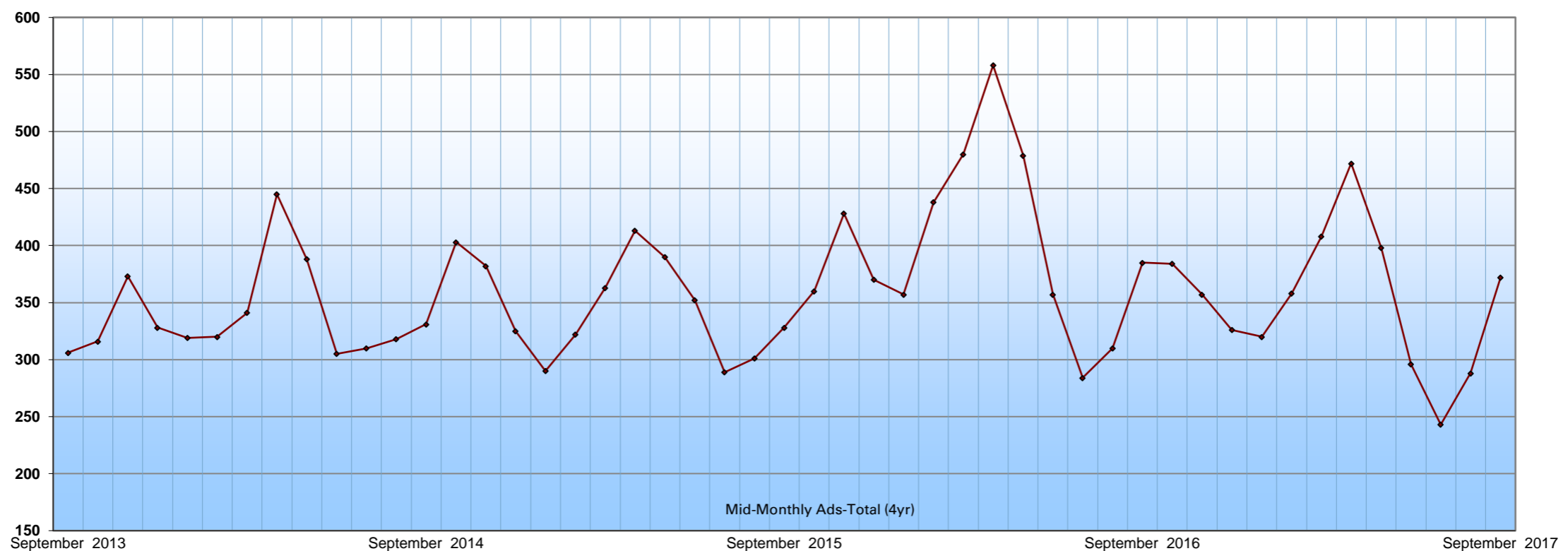


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

September 2017 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 372 internship ads were posted online from August 14, 2017, through September 13, 2017, for southwest Ohio. This was an increase of 84 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 13 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
