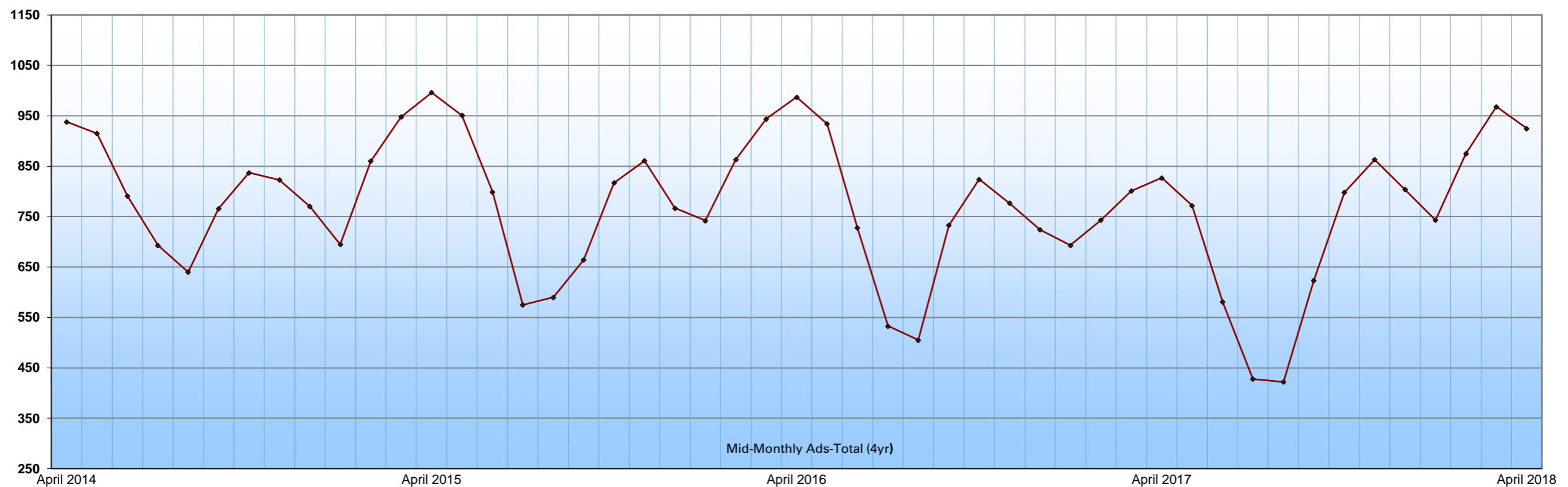


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Northeast JobsOhio Network

April 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 925 internship ads were posted online from March 14, 2018, through April 13, 2018, for northeast Ohio. This was a decrease of 43 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 98 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the past several years.
