


Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads in the Southwest JobsOhio Network

July 2018 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 273 internship ads were posted online from June 14, 2018, through July 13, 2018, for southwest Ohio. This was a decrease of 48 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of two ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
