

2016-2026 Ohio Employment Projections

Automotive Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2017, the automotive industry cluster’s average annual pay was **\$61,117¹**. During this same time period, Ohio’s statewide private industry average annual wage was \$48,577.
- The automotive industry is expected to provide **11,253** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
