

2016-2026 Ohio Employment Projections

Food and Agribusiness Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2017, the food and agribusiness industry cluster’s average annual pay was **\$50,404¹**. During this same time period, Ohio’s statewide private industry average annual wage was \$48,577.
- The food and agribusiness industry is expected to provide **8,073** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
