# Healthcare Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2017, the healthcare industry cluster’s average annual pay was **\$74,303<sup>1</sup>**. During this same time period, Ohio’s statewide private industry average annual wage was \$48,577.
- The healthcare industry is expected to provide **19,016** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
