Logistics and Distribution Industry SNAPSHOT

- In 2019, the logistics and distribution industry cluster's average annual pay was \$48,155¹. During this same time period, Ohio's statewide private industry average annual wage was \$51,726.
- The logistics and distribution industry is expected to provide **21,922** average annual job opportunities across all occupations within the cluster.
